There will be an available room for storage of your personal items that will be locked during the ceremony. We encourage you to leave these personal items with your family.

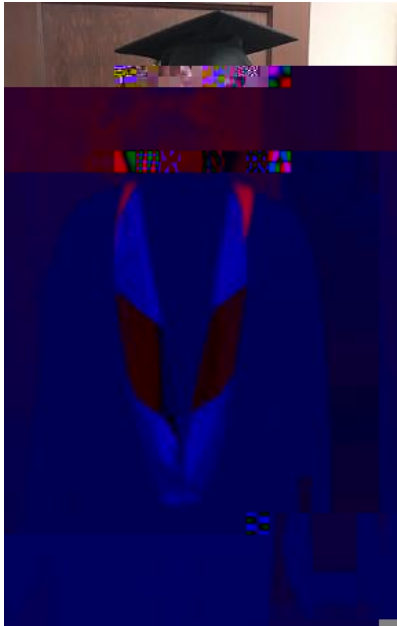
